CODE OF CONDUCT FOR BOARD MEMBERS

(Adopted 2000)

Members of the	School District Board of Education shall represent the public
interest in education by adhering to the following commitments:	

- 1. Representing all school district constituents honestly and equally, and refusing to surrender responsibilities to special interest or partisan political groups.
- 2. Avoiding any conflict of interest or the appearance of impropriety that could result from his/her position.
- 3. Avoiding the use of board membership for personal gain or publicity.
- 4. Recognizing that a board member has no legal authority as an individual and that decisions can be made only by a majority vote of the Board at a regular or special meeting.
- 5. Taking no private action that might compromise the Board or administration.
- 6. Respecting the confidentiality of privileged information.
- 7. Abiding by majority decisions of the Board while retaining the right to seek changes in such decisions through ethical and constructive channels.
- 8. Encouraging and respecting the free expression of opinion by fellow board members.
- 9. Being involved and knowledgeable about local educational concerns, and state and national issues.
